As has been identified in a recent mailing from Medtronic Benefits, medical benefits for <u>post-65</u> retirees will be changing on January 1, 2018. As such, the training and education portion for this change will be occurring in the upcoming months as follows.

<u>Week of May 30</u>: Mailing to post-65 / Medicare eligible retirees reminding them about the change and letting them know about onsite meetings/conference calls.

Week of June 26: Medtronic Corporate Benefits and private exchange vendor will hold introductory post-65 retiree meetings onsite in Minneapolis (TBD – and space will be limited) and via conference call.
